ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE OR A STATUS REPORT

Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, has applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. At a prehearing conference held on December 22, 2010, the presiding officer directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by January 3, 2011. Subsequently, at the request of the parties, the Commission extended that filing date until January 24, February 11, and then February 25. The parties have not yet filed a proposed procedural schedule, but they have reported that they are continuing discussions regarding the case and how to proceed.

The Commission will direct the parties to file either a proposed procedural schedule or a status report indicating when they expect to file a proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file either a proposed procedural schedule or a status report indicating when they will be able to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than March 21, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
