**ORDER GRANTING FURTHER TIME TO FILE PROPOSED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, has applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. At a prehearing conference held on December 22, 2010, the presiding officer directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by January 3, 2011. Subsequently, at the request of the parties, the Commission extended that filing date until January 24. On February 4, Public Counsel, acting on behalf of all the parties, asked for an additional extension of time to allow the parties until February 11 to file a proposed procedural schedule, a stipulation and agreement, or a report on the status of the parties' discussions.

The request for additional time is reasonable and the Commission will grant that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule, a stipulation and agreement, or a report on the status of their discussions no later than February 11, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
