NOTICE REGARDING STATUS OF CASE

Issue Date: October 11, 2011

On June 10, 2011 Thomas L. Chaney filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that his electric supplier be changed from Cuivre River Electric Cooperative, Inc. to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Cuivre River, Ameren and the Staff of the Commission all opine that the application should be denied.

The underlying reason Mr. Chaney requests a change of supplier is to take advantage of Ameren's solar rebate program. However, the constitutionality of that program is at issue in Circuit Court.¹ The Commission will stay this application until the Circuit Court resolves its matter. Thereafter, if the court determines that the program is not unconstitutional, the Commission will set this matter for an preliminary hearing.
