NOTICE REGARDING CHANGE REQUEST

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this Notice with the Missouri Public Service Commission to state as follows:

- 1. On July 5, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") and the parties to this case filed (or did not object to) a *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Resolving Ameren Missouri's MEEIA Filing* ("Stipulation"). The Commission approved the *Stipulation* by Order on August 1, 2012.
- 2. In part, the *Stipulation* provided for Ameren Missouri's implementation of 11 Demand-Side Management Programs pursuant to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA Programs"). The *Stipulation* requires Ameren Missouri to hire independent evaluation, measurement and verification ("EM&V") contractor(s) to complete EM&V reports ("EM&V Reports") on its MEEIA Programs each year and to file final EM&V Reports 135 days after the end of each MEEIA Program year.¹
- 3. The Stipulation also allows any stakeholder group that wants a change to the impact² evaluation portion of a final EM&V Report to file a request before the

² The impact evaluation will include estimations of annual energy savings in kWh and net benefits for each MEEIA Program and for the MEEIA portfolio.

Commission within 21 days of the filing of a final EM&V Report in this matter ("Change Request"). All Signatories to the *Stipulation* are bound by the impact evaluation portion of the final EM&V Report, as it may be modified by the Commission's resolution of any Change Request.

- 4. On May 15, 2014, Ameren Missouri filed final EM&V Reports prepared by its MEEIA Program EM&V contractors, The Cadmus Group, Inc. ("Cadmus") for its residential MEEIA Programs and ADM Associates, Inc. ("ADM") for its commercial and industrial MEEIA Programs.
- 5. On May 28, 2014, Ameren Missouri filed Revised EM&V Reports prepared by Cadmus for each of its residential MEEIA Programs. The Revised EM&V Reports were prepared to correct errors and inconsistencies of data which were identified in the May 15, 2014 filings.
- 6. Ameren Missouri and Staff are currently working together to identify areas of the Revised EM&V Reports where additional work needs to be performed by Cadmus. Staff understands that Cadmus will produce a new set of EM&V Reports for filing. Ameren Missouri and Staff agree that the 21 day period for filing a Change Request will not start to elapse under the *Stipulation* until Ameren Missouri files final EM&V Reports for the stakeholders' review.

WHEREFORE, Staff files this Notice for the Commission's information and consideration and states Staff and the Commission's auditor will file any necessary Change Request within 21 days of Ameren Missouri's filing of final EM&V Reports pursuant to the *Stipulation* in this case.
