ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO REVISE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 31, 2014, Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to revise the procedural schedule by delaying the evidentiary hearing from January 6-7, to February 9-10, 2015. The motion represents that the other parties to this case do not object to the rescheduling of the hearing. The motion asks the Commission to rule upon the motion no later than January 2 and suggests that any party wishing to respond to the motion do so by noon on January 2. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for responding to the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri's Motion to Revise Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment shall do so no later than 12:00 p.m. on January 2, 2015.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
