On July 17, 2014, the Commission established a procedural schedule to consider the change requests filed by the Commission's Staff and Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On July 30, Staff, acting on behalf of itself, Ameren Missouri, Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy, filed a motion asking the Commission to modify that procedural schedule. The motion explains that Staff and Ameren Missouri have reached a settlement in principle but need more time to conclude the settlement. Since the existing procedural schedule would require the filing of stakeholder responses by August 4, they ask that the schedule be extended by approximately thirty days to allow more time to complete their negotiations. The motion also represents that no party to the case objects to the modification of the procedural schedule.

The Commission will grant the motion to modify the procedural schedule.
