**ORDER POSTPONING ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION**

In response to the parties having announced an agreement in principle to unanimously resolve all issues regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri’s MEEIA filing to implement energy efficiency programs, the Commission indefinitely continued the evidentiary hearing to allow the parties an opportunity to reduce their agreement to writing. The Commission also scheduled an on-the-record presentation for June 4, 2012 to consider that agreement.

On May 31, Ameren Missouri, acting on behalf of the other parties, filed a motion asking the Commission to postpone the on-the-record presentation. Ameren Missouri explains that the parties are still working to reduce their agreement to writing but will not be able to have that agreement prepared and signed by June 4.

The Commission will postpone the on-the-record presentation from June 4 and will reschedule it as appropriate after the parties file their written agreement.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The on-the-record presentation to consider the agreement of the parties scheduled for June 4, 2012, is postponed until rescheduled by order of the Commission.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
