## ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS

On November 1, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO) through December 31, 2013. The Commission provided notice of the filing and established November 24, 2010, as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene on November 24. MIEC is a Missouri Corporation and its members are large industrial customers of Ameren Missouri. The individual members of MIEC are Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc., BioKyowa, Inc., The Boeing Company, Doe Run, Enbridge, General Motors Corporation, GKN Aerospace, Hussmann Corporation, JW Aluminum, MEMC Electronic Materials, Monsanto, Precoat Metals, Proctor & Gamble Company, Nestlé Purina Petcare, Noranda Aluminum, Saint Gobain, Solutia, and U.S. Silica Company. More than ten days have passed since MIEC and its individual members applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that the interest of MIEC and its individual members in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC and its individual members to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application to Intervene of The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers and its individual members is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
