## **ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF THE MIDWEST INDEPENDENT TRANSMISSION SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC.**

On November 1, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO) through December 31, 2013. The Commission provided notice of the filing and established November 24, 2010, as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

The Midwest ISO applied to intervene on November 9. The Midwest ISO is a regional transmission organization and is the entity to which Ameren Missouri seeks to continue to transfer control of its electric transmission system. More than ten days have passed since the Midwest ISO applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that the interest of the Midwest ISO in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing the Midwest ISO to intervene

will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application to Intervene of the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
