**ORDER ADDING HEARING DATES**

Effective Date: April 24, 2012

On April 24, 2012, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to add two days to the scheduled hearing for this case. The motion explains that the hearing is currently set for two days, May 24 and 25. The parties anticipate that as many as twenty witnesses may testify and they doubt that two days of hearing will be sufficient. For that reason, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to add one day of hearing to the start of the hearing on May 23. Ameren Missouri also suggests the Commission reserve a fourth day in June for continuation of the hearing if it cannot be completed in three days. Ameren Missouri’s motion represents that counsel for all parties have indicated they do not object to the proposal to add days to the hearing.

Ameren Missouri’s plan to add hearing days is reasonable and the Commission will add the requested hearing dates. The existing procedural schedule requires the parties to file initial briefs on June 6, with reply briefs to follow on June 20. The Commission will not change those dates at this time, but may need to do so if the hearing is not completed on May 25.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule is modified to provide that the evidentiary hearing shall begin on May 23, 2012, and continue on May 24 and 25, 2012.
2. June 4, 2012 is reserved on the Commission's calendar for an additional hearing day if the hearing is not concluded on May 25, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
