## ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT MODIFYING INCENTIVE AMOUNTS

Issue Date: September 16, 2015

Effective Date: September 26, 2015

On September 3, 2015, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Commission, the Missouri Division of Energy and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement that modifies certain previously-approved incentive amounts for the remaining months in which Ameren Missouri's 2012 MEEIA plan will be in effect.

The stipulation and agreement is non-unanimous in that it was not signed by all parties. However, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2) provides that other parties have seven days in which to object to a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement. If no party files a timely objection to a stipulation and agreement, the Commission may treat it as a unanimous stipulation and agreement. More than seven days have passed since the stipulation and agreement was filed, and no party has objected. Therefore, the Commission will treat the stipulation and agreement as a unanimous stipulation and agreement.

After reviewing the stipulation and agreement, the Commission independently finds and concludes that the stipulation and agreement is a reasonable resolution of the issues addressed, and that such stipulation and agreement should be approved. Because this stipulation and agreement is unopposed and because customers will benefit from the prompt approval of these revised incentive measures, the Commission will make this order effective in less than thirty days.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Non-unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed on September 3, 2015, is approved as a resolution of the issues addressed in that stipulation and agreement. The signatory parties are ordered to comply with the terms of the stipulation and agreement. A copy of the stipulation and agreement is attached to this order.

- 2. This order shall be effective on September 26, 2015.
- 3. This file shall be closed on September 27, 2015.
