ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF APPLICATION, ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION FILING DATE, AND SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On January 20, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri applied to the Commission for approval of the company's Technical Resource Manual (TRM) and a Demand-Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) as contemplated by the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) and the Commission's implementing regulations. The Commission will provide notice of Ameren Missouri's application to potentially interested individuals and entities and will invite them to apply to intervene as parties.

As Ameren Missouri's application explains, the Commission's rule requires the Commission to act on that application within 120 days. Therefore, the Commission will require applications to intervene to be filed quickly.¹ The Commission will also schedule a prehearing conference at which the parties may discuss how the Commission should best proceed to consider Ameren Missouri's application.

¹ Potential parties should be aware that even if they do not file their application to intervene within the time set by this order, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(10) allows the Commission to accept late-filed applications to intervene upon a showing of good cause to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each party to Ameren Missouri's pending IRP case (EO-2011-0271), to the county commission of each county within Ameren Missouri's service area, and to the corresponding governmental body serving the City of St. Louis.
- 2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the counties within Ameren Missouri's service area, and to the news media serving that service area.
 - 3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than January 27, 2012.
- 4. Any party wishing to respond to any application to intervene shall do so no later than February 1, 2012.
- 5. A prehearing conference is scheduled for February 2, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
