## ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND CANCELING HEARING

On February 5, 2015, the Commission's Staff, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a joint motion asking the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule for this case. The motion explains that the parties have reached an agreement in principle to settle all pending issues, thus eliminating the need for an evidentiary hearing. They anticipate filing either a stipulation and agreement to finalize their agreement, or a status report, no later than February 10.

The Commission will suspend the procedural schedule and will cancel the hearing scheduled for February 9 and 10.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule previously established for this case is indefinitely suspended.

2. The hearing scheduled for February 9 and 10, 2015, is canceled.
