ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

Issue Date: January 18, 2011

Effective Date: January 18, 2011

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Application for Intervention* ("motion"). The Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") filed the motion on January 4, 2011. No party has filed a response within the time provided by regulation.¹

The motion is subject to the following standard:

The commission may on application permit any person to intervene on a showing that—

(A) The proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or

(B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest [²]

DNR cites its duties under:

. . . Section 640.150, RSMo. which includes planning for energy resource development; analyzing energy management issues; consulting and cooperating with all state and federal governmental agencies on matters of energy research and development, management, conservation and distribution; assessing the potential impacts on environmental quality; and analyzing the potential for increased use of energy alternatives and making recommendations for the expanded use of such alternate energy sources and technologies. Those considerations meet the standard for intervention.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Application for Intervention* is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
