NOTICE OF APPLICATION, ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR INTERVENTION AND ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

The Commission is giving notice of an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity, setting a deadline for motions to intervene, and directing its staff to file a recommendation. Applications to intervene are due 30 days after the issuance of this notice.¹ The statutory requirement of a “due hearing”² allows the Commission to grant an unopposed application without conducting a hearing.³

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve this notice and order on the commissioners of the Buchanan County Commission.
2. The Commission’s information officer shall make this notice and order available to the:

- a. members of the Missouri General Assembly whose districts include the proposed service area described in the body of this order, and
 - b. media serving the proposed service area.
3. Any motion for intervention is due no later than January 7, 2011. Any person filing such a motion shall send the motion to:

4. Staff shall file its recommendation as to the application no later than January 14, 2011.
5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
