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ANSWER

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE" or "Company"), and for its Answer to the Complaint filed in this proceeding, states as follows:

- 1. On July 5, 2005, John B. Jackson of 4954 Kemper Avenue, 2E, St. Louis, Missouri, ("Complainant") initiated this proceeding by filing a Complaint against AmerenUE.
- 2. In paragraph 1 of the Complaint, Complainant alleges that AmerenUE is located at One Ameren Plaza, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, and that AmerenUE is a public utility under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri. AmerenUE admits the allegations contained in paragraph 1 of the Complaint. AmerenUE notes that the above-referenced address is in St. Louis, Missouri.
- 3. In paragraph 2 of the Complaint, the Complainant alleges that AmerenUE has "fail[ed] to define [the] monetary amount or percentage if any" that he is legally responsible for. Complainant also alleges that unspecified disputed charges are still in question.
- 4. In his request for relief, Complainant requests an itemized statement showing the true amount he is legally responsible for.

5. In his request for relief, the Complainant requests that AmerenUE provide an

itemized statement showing true amount he is legally responsible for.

AmerenUE denies the allegation that it has failed to define the monetary amount

that Complainant owes for his electric bill. AmerenUE has provided the Complainant with an

itemized bill that includes an unpaid amount from a previous address where the Complainant

resided. A copy of Complainant's current bill, as well as related previous bills are attached

hereto as a highly confidential Exhibit A. AmerenUE also denies that there are any charges that

are the subject of any legitimate dispute. Finally, AmerenUE notes that the only relief requested

by the Complainant, an itemized statement showing the true amount he is legally responsible for,

has been provided.

WHEREFORE AmerenUE respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order

dismissing this Complaint. In the alternative, AmerenUE requests that it issue an order requiring

its Staff to conduct an independent investigation of this Complaint, and to file a report of its

findings with the Commission.
