ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION TO COMPEL RESPONSES TO DATA REQUESTS

On November 4, 2011, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to issue an order compelling Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri to answer several data requests submitted by Public Counsel. The Commission directed interested parties to respond to that motion by November 10. On that date, Ameren Missouri filed a motion requesting additional time to file its response.

Ameren Missouri explains that it has resolved most of Public Counsel's concerns about the contested data requests and asks that it be allowed until November 14 to continue discussions to resolve the remaining concerns before having to file its response to the motion to compel. Ameren Missouri represents that Public Counsel does not object to its request for additional time to respond.

Given the agreement of the interested parties, the Commission will grant Ameren Missouri's request for additional time to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Motion for Order Compelling Responses to Data Requests shall do so no later than November 14, 2011. 2 This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
