On September 2, 2011, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to clarify three of the questions it directed Staff to answer in its upcoming testimony. The Commission offers the following clarification:

- a. With regard to question number 5, Staff's assumption is correct, the question refers to solely a consolidated balancing authority;
- b. The reference to the \$100 million cost to integrate Entergy into the MISO system may be found in the Evaluation Report Filed by Entergy Arkansas, Inc., before the Arkansas Public Service Commission on May 12, 2011, in Docket No. 10-011-U.
- c. With regard to question number 13, Staff's assumption is correct, the question intended to refer to question 13(b) rather than 12(b)
