**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING A DEADLINE
FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE**

On December 22, 2011, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed the above-titled application. The Commission will direct notice and will establish a deadline for applications to intervene. Due to the 120-day deadline imposed upon the Commission by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.094(3), the Commission will also now set a prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon each party to File No. ER-2010-0355.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within Kansas City Power & Light Company's service area.
3. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Kansas City Power & Light Company's service area and to the news media serving Kansas City Power & Light Company's service area.

4. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an appropriate pleading no later than January 13, 2012, with:

5. A prehearing conference shall be held on January 17, 2012, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. That room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
