**ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On November 4, 2011, The Cathedral Square Corporation filed the above-referenced application for variance. Staff recommends the Commission grant the variance. But Kansas City Power & Light opposes the variance.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their attorneys shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They shall be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. Also, the parties shall be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall prepare and file a joint proposed procedural schedule or, in the event the parties cannot agree on a procedural schedule, each party shall file its own proposed schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on December 22, 2011, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street,

Jefferson City, Missouri. That room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. Any party wishing to appear by telephone may do so may calling 573-522-5993.

3. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule or, in the alternative, each party shall file its own proposed procedural schedule, no later than January 5, 2012.

4. This order shall become effective on immediately upon issuance.
