On February 29, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to accept the late-filed affidavit of Rick Voytas to accompany Exhibit A attached to Ameren Missouri's Response to Motion for Variance Determination and Motion for Expedited Treatment and Response to Joint Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule, which was filed on February 24.
