ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO SUBMIT A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND CONFIRMING INTERVENTION OF PARTIES

At the on-the-record portion of the procedural conference held on February 2, 2012, the Commission ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by February 6, 2012. After meeting informally, the parties informed the presiding officer that they would not be able to submit a proposed procedural schedule by the appointed time and requested that they be allowed until February 10 to submit either an agreed upon procedural schedule, competing motions requesting establishment of a procedural schedule, or a status report indicating when such a schedule or competing motions may be filed. The Commission will modify its previous order as requested by the parties.

Also, various parties were allowed to intervene by order made on the record at the procedural conference. For purposes of the Commission's record-keeping, the Commission will confirm those interventions in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than February 10, 2012, the parties shall file either an agreed upon procedural schedule, competing motions requesting establishment of a procedural

schedule, or a status report indicating when such a schedule or competing motions may be filed.

2. The Commission confirms that the following parties have been allowed to intervene:

Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company;

Laclede Gas Company;

Missouri Department of Natural Resources;

Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, and the Natural Resources

Defense Council;

Barnes-Jewish Hospital; and

The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
