On November 9, 2011, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) submitted an application to sell coal and lease a small portion of its property at the Rush Island Power Plant as part of program to utilize refined coal in order to lower costs and reduce emissions. Ameren Missouri is seeking expedited treatment for its application, and the Commission has placed this matter on an expedited procedural schedule. Several entities filed timely requests to intervene. The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, is granted.
2. The application to intervene filed by the Barnes-Jewish Hospital is granted.
3. The application to intervene filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is granted.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
