## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On November 10, 2011, Kansas City Power and Light Company ("KCPL") submitted a motion "requesting that the Commission extend its existing authority to sell and trade S02 emissions allowances to the NOx emissions allowances that will no longer be useable for compliance post-December 31, 2011, and record such sales proceeds in FERC account 254, to be flowed to customers over an amortization period to be determined in the next rate case with the unamortized balance to be used as an offset to ratebase." KCPL seeks expedited treatment (a Commission decision by November 23, 2011), and states that to facilitate this process it is serving its application on all parties to its most recent rate case. KCPL further states that the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel support its motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within Kansas City Power and Light Company's service area.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon all parties to File No. ER-2010-0355 and add those parties to the certified service list for this file.

3. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Kansas City Power and Light Company's service area and to the news media serving Kansas City Power and Light Company's service area.

4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, no later than November 18, 2011, file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of Kansas City Power and Light Company's motion.

5. Any other party, or interested person or entity, that wishes to file a response to Kansas City Power and Light Company's motion, or that wishes to request a hearing, shall file said response or request no later than November 18, 2011.

6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
