Good afternoon, Judge Jones.

This will serve to confirm the call placed to you this morning by Renee Parsons, attorney for applicant Aquila, and me concerning the two referenced cases. The purpose of the call was to advise you that counsel for the company, Staff, Public Counsel and KCPL had an agreement in principle that, when reduced to writing, will be filed in each case. If approved by the Commission, it would provide the basis for a comprehensive settlement of both cases. Ms. Parsons and I currently are preparing a written agreement that, if acceptable to the other parties in the case will be filed within the next week or so.

You reminded us that the company had, in its Applications, requested an order from the Commission bearing an effective date of not later than August 15th. Although Aquila remains keenly interested in quick action on its two requests, the company would request that the Commission hold off taking any action until the parties have had an opportunity to make their collective written recommendation to the Commission. We will endeavor to keep you advised throughout this process.
