ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION DATE AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On May 6, 2011, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) applied for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to acquire and operate certain electrical production facilities in Kansas City, Missouri. Specifically, KCP&L seeks to install small rooftop solar facilities in the Smart-Grid Demonstration Area. KCP&L asks that the Commission act to approve its request by June 15, 2011, so that it can begin installation of the facilities as part of an anticipated public event that will be held this summer.

Before acting on KCP&L's application, the Commission will establish an intervention date and will require a recommendation from its Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any person or entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than May 23, 2011.
- 2. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's application no later than May 27, 2011.

- 3. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's application shall do so no later than May 27, 2011.
 - 4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
