**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE,  
DIRECTING FILING AND SCHEDULING A CONFERENCE**

On August 31, 2012, Transource Missouri, L.L.C. (“Transource”) filed an application for a line Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to construct, finance, own, operate, and maintain the regional Iatan-Nashua 345kV transmission project (“Iatan-Nashua Project”) and the regional Sibley-Nebraska City 345kV transmission project (“Sibley-Nebraska City Project,” collectively, the “Projects”) that have been approved by Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (“SPP”) to provide regional benefits to Missouri and the entire Mid-America region. Contemporaneously with that filing, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) submitted an application for authority to transfer, at cost, certain transmission property to Transource in relation to the Projects.

The Commission will give notice of these applications to potentially interested parties, will set an intervention deadline and will schedule a joint procedural conference.

Additionally, the Commission shall direct its Staff to investigate and file a report and recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order and the applications to the parties to Kansas City Power & Light Company's and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's on-going rate cases, File Numbers ER-2012-0174 and ER-2012-0175.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order and the applications to the Southwest Power Pool, Inc.

3. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order and the applications to NW Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., Platte-Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc., ONEOK, Inc., and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway.

4. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media in service areas of KCP&L, GMO and SPP and to the members of the General Assembly representing these service areas.

5. Notice may be provided electronically.

6. No later than September 17, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall identify any other entity that should receive notice of these applications.

7. Any person or entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application no later than September 28, 2012 with:

A joint procedural conference for these two matters is scheduled for October 15, 2012, at 9:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 9. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall investigate and file a report and recommendation regarding these applications no later than November 5, 2012.
