**ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF ESTIMATES OF RESIDENTIAL
CUSTOMER CLASS REVENUE NEUTRAL INTERCLASS SHIFT**

An issue presented for determination in this case concerns the appropriate level for a revenue neutral shift to the Residential Customer Class, based on the proposed decrease in the residential subsidy to the cost of service. As discussed at its June 11, 2015 agenda meeting, the Commission will direct The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), and the Staff of the Commission to file estimates of the increase to an average residential customer with the 0.75% increase proposed by the signatories to the *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement on Certain Issues* and under MECG's proposed elimination of 25% of the residential subsidy.

The parties should include dollar estimates for both values with the increase to a residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt hours monthly, inclusive of the 3.9% revenue requirement increase. In addition, the parties should include estimates of the total increase for the Residential Customer Class under both proposed revenue neutral interclass shifts. The parties should also identify the revenue neutral changes for the various classes based on Staff's Detailed BIP CCROSS results (Exhibit 210) under MECG's proposed adjustments.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Empire, MECG and Staff shall jointly or separately file the information described in the body of this Order no later than Monday, June 15, 2015.
2. Other parties may file their calculations of the requested information no later than Monday, June 15, 2015.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
