**ORDER ACCEPTING POST-HEARING EXHIBITS REGARDING  
RATE CASE EXPENSE**

On August 12, 2015, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") filed a Rate Case Expense Update with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to a stipulation and agreement that was approved by the Commission. The filing included a highly confidential attachment that updated rate case expense information as of the date of the filing. Other parties responded to the filing, including Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), who submitted alternative attachments that described rate case expense items in more detail. Staff and OPC requested that their attachments also be admitted into the record of the hearing. More than ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the requests by Staff and OPC.<sup>1</sup> The Commission will grant the requests and admit all three attachments.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's highly confidential attachment to its Rate Case Expense Update, filed on August 12, 2015, and attached to this order, is marked as Exhibit 169 HC and admitted into the record of the hearing.
