**COMMISSIONER RUPP'S ORDER
DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE ALLEGATION**

On June 6, 2018, Commissioner Scott T. Rupp and Ryan A. Silvey received an email regarding an allegation against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO).¹ The allegation stated that KCP&L and GMO take longer than 90 days to approve net metering and solar rebate applications for systems over 10 kilowatts. However, Section 386.890.7(1) RSMo., requires retail electric suppliers to review and respond to such applications within ninety (90) days.

Commissioner Rupp orders Staff to investigate this allegation and provide its findings in its rebuttal testimony-rate design in the above styled cases on August 7, 2018. Staff's investigation should include a recommendation as to whether these allegations are better addressed in a complaint case or other proceeding before the Commission. Any other party wishing to file comments regarding these allegations may do so on or before

August 7, 2018, in its rebuttal testimony-rate design or a separate filing. Any party wishing to respond to Staff's findings may do so on or before September 4, 2018 in its surrebuttal testimony or a separate filing.

COMMISSIONER RUPP ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff investigate the allegation stated above regarding KCP&L and GMO's compliance with the Section 386.890.7(1) RSMo., of the Net Metering and Easy Connection Act and provide its findings in its rebuttal testimony-rate design in the above styled cases on August 7, 2018.

2. Any other party wishing to file comments regarding these allegations may do so on or before August 7, 2018, in its rebuttal testimony-rate design or a separate filing.

3. Any party wishing to respond to Staff's findings may do so on or before September 4, 2018 in its surrebuttal testimony or a separate filing.
