According to the requirements described in 4 CSR 240-32.200(4) notice shall be given to certain entities within the 211 applicant's proposed area. These entities are as follows:

All ILECs: Use the Data Center's list of all ILECs.

Facility-based CLECs: The Staff recommends notice be given to all CLECs and all interconnected VoIP providers on the Data Center's list.

Counties: The counties that are within this area are listed in Paragraph No. 32 of UWGSL's application.

Human Service/Social Service organizations: The Staff recommends the same approach be used as in the prior 211 application case for UWGSL (Case No. TO-2007-0312) where UWGSL was directed to notify all the agencies it funds.

Cities with 5,000+ population: Set forth below is a list of the cities with 5,000 or more in population within the area served by United Way of Greater St. Louis. City populations are based on information from www.census.gov which identifies this information as population as of July 1, 2008.
