On September 4, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed the above-referenced application and tariff in File No. ET-2014-0059.¹ On September 10, 2013, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed the above-referenced application and tariff in File No. ET-2014-0071.

On October 3, KCP&L, GMO, the Staff of the Commission ("Staff"), the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), The Missouri Division of Energy ("MDOE"), Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), Missouri Solar Energy Industry Association ("MOSEIA"), Brightergy, LLC ("Brightergy"), and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation").

The Commission will schedule an on-the-record presentation for the parties to answer bench questions concerning the stipulation.
