## ORDER OPENING A CASE

On September 10, 2013, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to open a case to facilitate and retain discovery regarding Staff's audit of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's construction of pollution control equipment at its Labadie Energy Center. This is not a contested case. Any consideration of the prudence of Ameren Missouri's investment will occur in a subsequent rate case and not in this case. The Commission will open a case as Staff requests.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This case is opened to facilitate and retain discovery regarding Staff's audit of Ameren Missouri's construction of pollution control equipment at its Labadie Energy Center.
2. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri is made a party to this case.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
