**ORDER EXTENDING TIME**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Extension of Time to File Staff’s Reports*<sup>1</sup> (“motion”). In the motion, Staff asks for more time to file the reports on the annual report and annual plan<sup>2</sup> (“RES report and plan”) of Ameren Missouri regarding renewable energy standards (“RES”).<sup>3</sup> Those reports are ordinarily due 45 days after the filing of the RES report and plan.<sup>4</sup>

In support of the motion, Staff cites the Commission’s regulation allowing a variance from that deadline for good cause.<sup>5</sup> Good cause means a good faith request for reasonable relief.<sup>6</sup> Staff alleges the maternity leave of a key Staff member, cites the press of other business regarding Ameren, and represents that no party objects to the motion. The relief sought is a 30-day extension for the reports of Staff and a concomitant extension of the time for comments by other persons. Such pleading shows good cause.
