**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION

On May 21, 2015¹, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed an Unopposed Motion to Reschedule Evidentiary Hearings. THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Unopposed Motion to Reschedule Evidentiary Hearings is granted.

The evidentiary hearing shall be held on July 20-22, 2015, beginning at 8:30 a.m. each day, at the Commission’s offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Room 310, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
