**ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Commission set a procedural schedule in its *Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on September 23, 2015. On October 6, 2015, Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, the Commission's Staff, and Brightergy, LLC ("Movants") filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule. Movants have requested more time to file rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony, but those proposed changes would result in less time for the Commissioners to prepare for the evidentiary hearing. Movants state that these proposed changes to the procedural schedule would facilitate settlement negotiations among the parties. The Commission wishes to encourage the parties to negotiate a settlement of this matter, so it will grant Movants' request to extend the deadline for filing rebuttal testimony to October 21, 2015. However, their remaining proposed changes to the procedural schedule would not provide adequate time for the Commissioners to prepare for the evidentiary hearing, so those requests will be denied.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, Commission's Staff, and Brightergy, LLC's *Motion to Extend Procedural Schedule*, is granted, in part, and denied, in part, as described in the body of this order.
2. The deadline for the parties to file rebuttal testimony in this case is extended until no later than October 21, 2015.
3. All other provisions of the Commission's *Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on September 23, 2015, shall remain unchanged.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
