ORDER AMENDING ORDER GRANTING AUTHORITY TO CONTINUE SERVING AS A 2-1-1 INFORMATION AND REFERRAL SERVICE PROVIDER

Issue Date: March 27, 2017 Effective Date: March 27, 2017

On March 22, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Authority to Continue Serving as a 2-1-1 Information and Referral Service Provider* (the "Order"). The Order included Staff's recommendation that all certified and registered telecommunications companies and IVoIP providers in the exchange area be required to reconfigure their switches so callers access the United Way of Greater St. Louis when dialing 2-1-1. The Order goes into effect on April 17, 2017.

After the Order was issued, Staff amended its recommendation to remove the request that relevant telecommunication companies and IVoIP providers be required to reconfigure their switches so callers access the United Way of Greater St. Louis when dialing 2-1-1. Staff states, "...reconfiguring the switches is a difficult process and is unnecessary."

After considering Staff's latest recommendation, the Commission will amend the Order to remove the requirement in Ordered Paragraph 2. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to inform all local telecommunication and IVoIP providers that are impacted by the Order of this revision.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's March 22, 2017 Order Granting Authority to Continue Serving as a 2-1-1 Information and Referral Service Provider is amended to remove the requirement in Ordered Paragraph 2, that certified or registered telecommunications companies and IVoIP providers in the exchange area reconfigure their switches so that local callers reach the United Way of Greater St. Louis by dialing 2-1-1.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the telecommunication companies affected by the March 22, 2017 *Order Granting Authority to Continue Serving as a 2-1-1 Information and Referral Service Provider*.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
