On April 10, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company submitted an application and tariff designed to establish a renewable energy standard rate adjustment mechanism pursuant to Section 393.1030, RSMo Supp. 2013, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(6). On May 19, 2014, the Commission held a procedural conference with the parties, at which the presiding officer issued the following orders:

1. The application of Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri to intervene as a party is granted.
2. The application of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri to intervene as a party is granted.
3. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(6)(A), Staff shall file a report regarding its examination and analysis of the application no later than August 8, 2014.

4. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(6)(A), any other party granted intervention may file comments regarding the application no later than August 8, 2014.
