**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The Commission issued an order on September 22, 2014 requiring the parties to file a joint list of issues, statements of position, and a joint stipulation of facts no later than October 2, 2014. On October 2, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), on behalf of all the parties, filed a request for an extension of time. GMO states in its motion that the parties continue to discuss the issues but may not be able to stipulate to all the facts necessary for a resolution of this matter. GMO proposes that the deadline be extended until October 16, 2014 for the required filings, or in lieu thereof, a stipulation and agreement and an amended procedural schedule. The Commission finds the request to be reasonable and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The deadline for the parties to file a joint list of issues, statements of position, and joint stipulation of facts shall be extended until no later than October 16, 2014. If necessary, the parties may instead file a stipulation and agreement and propose an amended procedural schedule no later than October 16, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
