ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 15, 2013, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission their 2014 Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100. The Commission directed that a Staff report and any comments by interested persons be filed no later than May 30, 2014. On May 27, 2014, Ag Processing, Inc. filed a motion in File No. EO-2014-0288 to extend the time to file comments until June 9, 2014. The Commission ordered that any person wishing to respond or object to the request for an extension of time do so no later than 12:00 noon on May 29, 2014. On May 28, 2014, Staff filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file the Staff report and any comments until June 30, 2014. No party has objected to the requests.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(10) states that the Commission may waive or grant a variance from a provision of the renewable energy standard rule, such as the time for filing a Staff report and comments by interested persons, for good cause shown. Good

cause means a good faith request for reasonable relief.¹ Staff states in its motion that additional time is needed to complete its report because it is still engaged in the discovery process. Similarly, other parties are also waiting for information from the companies before submitting their comments. The Commission finds that good cause exists for extending the deadline to file the Staff report and comments by other parties and will grant Staff's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's motion for an extension of time to file reports filed on May 28, 2014, is granted.

2. The deadline for Staff to file its report and for the Office of Public Counsel and other interested persons to file comments to the compliance plans shall be extended until no later than June 30, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
