**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On June 11, 2014<sup>1</sup>, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") asked the Commission to approve its residential lighting program. At the same time, GMO filed a tariff that has an effective date of July 11. But GMO asks that the tariff go into effect on July 6 to coincide with Kansas City Power & Light's ("KCP&L") similar residential lighting program.

The Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation no later than June 25. On June 24, Staff filed a Request for Extension of Time.

In its Request, Staff states that GMO's June 11 filing contains errors. Staff further states that it has informed GMO of those errors, and that GMO plans to correct them. Thus, to allow for time for GMO to correct its errors, and for Staff to respond to the corrections, Staff needs until June 27 to file a Recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable. The Commission will grant the request.
