On January 2, 2015, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion for an Extension of Time and Request for an Evidentiary Hearing. The Commission provided an opportunity for other parties to respond to the motion for extension of time. Staff does not object to the motion, but objects to the request for hearing because it did not identify any issues in dispute. Ameren Missouri also objects to a lack of specificity in the request for hearing. The Commission finds the request for an extension of time reasonable and will grant it. Presumably, the response from the Office of Public Counsel will either identify any disputed issues regarding the Staff Report, or if none, withdraw the request for hearing.
