Staff’s Correction to Response to Order Directing Filing

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and corrects its *Response to Order Directing Filing* as follows:

In its April 14, 2011, response to the Commission’s April 12 and 13, 2011, *Orders Directing Filing*, Staff stated the impact to a residential customer using 1,130 kWh per month in the summer and 780 kWh in the winter is an average increase of \$4.85 per month, or 5.23%. The residential customer for which the increase was reported is one not taking service under a residential space heating rate schedule. Since that filing Staff has learned it made an error in how it determined that reported illustrative increase. Instead of \$4.85 per month, or 5.23%, the correct average increase is \$4.56 per month, or 4.91%. To Staff’s knowledge, in all other respects its response is otherwise correct.

WHEREFORE, Staff corrects its *Response to Order Directing Filing* to change the average impact of the ordered revenue requirement increase on the typical residential customer from \$4.85 per month, or 5.23%, to \$4.56 per month, or 4.91%.
