ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND GRANTING MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF COUNSEL PRO HAC VICE

On June 30, 2010, the Federal Executive Agencies filed a request to intervene in this case. The FEA consists of certain agencies of the United States Government which have offices, facilities, and/or installations In the service area of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company. Thus, the FEA has an interest in this case different from that of the general public. No responses to the request to intervene have been filed.

FEA's counsel, Captain Shayla McNeill, USAF, Air Force Civil Engineer Support Agency (AFCESA), filed a request for admission *pro hac vice*, designating Steven E. Jones, Lt. Col, USAFR, as associate counsel. On July 26, 2010, Lt. Col. Jones filed his entry of appearance, stating that he is a member of the Missouri bar in good standing. In addition, he states that Captain McNeill is an attorney in good standing admitted to practice before the Courts of Florida and has never been disqualified from practice in any jurisdiction. A receipt indicating Captain McNeill's payment of the fees required by Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) has been filed.

The Commission finds that the FEA has met the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.075 and is therefore granted intervention. Further, the Commission finds that Captain McNeill's request for admission complies with the requirements of 4 CSR

240-2.040(3)(C) and with Missouri Supreme Court rules 6.01(m) and 9.03, and she is granted leave to appear on behalf of the FEA.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Federal Executive Agencies' request to intervene is granted.
- 2. Captain Shayla McNeill is granted leave to appear on behalf of the Federal Executive Agencies.
 - 3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
