## ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES TO APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Timely applications to intervene have been filed by: Dogwood Energy, LLC, on June 9, 2010; the City of Kansas City, Missouri, on June 15, 2010; and Ag Processing Inc., a Cooperative, Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association (SIEUA), and Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, all on June 16, 2010. Ag Processing and SIEUA also filed motions for expedited consideration of their applications.

Inasmuch as the Commission has scheduled an early prehearing conference in this case on July 6, 2010, the Commission will shorten the filing deadline for responses to these applications to intervene so that the Commission may rule on them prior to the prehearing.

1. Any responses to the applications to intervene of Dogwood Energy, LLC, City of Kansas City, Missouri, Ag Processing Inc., a Cooperative, Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association, and Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, shall be filed no later than June 23, 2010.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
