ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed its 2012 Integrated Resource Plan on April 9, 2012. On April 12, the Commission issued an order directing that notice of that filing be sent to potentially interested parties. That order established May 3 as the deadline for applications to intervene.

The Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG); Dogwood Energy, LLC; The City of Kansas City, Missouri; the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission (MJMEUC); the Midwest Energy Users' Association (MEUA); and Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, filed timely applications to intervene. More than ten days have passed since those applications were filed and no party has objected to any of the applications.

The Commission finds that the interest of each of the applicants to intervene is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing each of the applicants to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with

- 7. The application to intervene of the Midwest Energy Users' Association is granted.
