OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS**

On April 9, 2012, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") its 2012 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. The purpose of the IRP is to ensure that investor-owned electric utilities, such as GMO, consider all options, including demand-side efficiency and energy management measures, so as to provide safe, reliable and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates, in a manner that serves the public interest.

As required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(6), the Commission will give notice of GMO's filing to potentially interested parties and will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving GMO's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing GMO's service area.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall deliver a copy of this order to any entity or association that was a party in File Nos. ER-2010-0356 or EO-2007-0298, or both.

3. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than May 3, 2012. Such applications shall be filed with:
