ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On June 10, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, Missouri Division of Energy, Consumers Council of Missouri, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, Natural Resources Defense Council, National Housing Trust, and Tower Grove Neighborhood Community Development Corporation (collectively referred to as "Signatories") filed a Stipulation and Agreement Amending Savings Calculations for Income Eligible Programs. The Signatories stated that the non-signatory parties do not oppose its approval.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.115(2) provides that parties that are not signatories to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement have seven days in which to object to that agreement. If no party files a timely objection to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement, the Commission may treat it as a unanimous stipulation and agreement. Thus, the Commission will set out the time for responses or objections below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any responses or objections to the Stipulation and Agreement Amending Savings Calculations for Income Eligible Programs filed on June 10, 2020, shall be filed no later than June 17, 2020.

2. This order is effective when issued.
