**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWL OF MOTION TO COMPEL**

**COMES NOW**, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), by and through counsel, and states as follows:

1.        On August 1, 2018, the OPC filed its Motion to Compel in response to Ameren Missouri’s repeated refusal to answer OPC data requests (DR) 2001 through 2003.
2.        On August 9, 2018, Ameren Missouri answered the OPC’s DRs.
3.        The OPC’s Motion to Compel is now moot, and need not be adjudicated at this time before the Public Service Commission.
4.        The OPC now withdraws its prior Motion to Compel only because its DRs have been answered, and makes no admissions or statements as to any relevancy or admissibility dispute regarding any information discovered through DRs 2001 through 2003.

**WHEREFORE**, the OPC withdraws its Motion to Compel.
