ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On November 18, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed revised tariff sheets designed to implement the terms of the *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding the Implementation Certain MEEIA Programs Through Plan Year 2022* approved by the Commission on November 11, 2021.¹ The revised tariff sheets include revisions to the Pay as You Save® (PAYS®) program which will be made available in 2021. The revised tariff sheets have a December 18, 2020 effective date.

Ameren Missouri states that it has shared the revised tariff sheets with the Commission Staff and incorporated Staff's suggested changes. The Commission will set a time for responses or objections to the revised tariff sheets and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than November 30, 2020, the Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff sheets set out in Tracking No. YE-2021-0119.

2. Any other responses or objections to Ameren Missouri's tariff sheets, Tracking No. YE-2021-0119, shall be filed no later than November 30, 2020.

3. This order is effective when issued.
